A court’s determination of custody and parenting time is based on “the best interests of the child”. An understanding of the requirements set forth in New York State Domestic Relations Law and the Family Court Act as well as the cases which have amplified the statutory parameters is a prerequisite to a psychotherapist’s ability to assist patients, both parent and child, during custody disputes. Therapists are frequently subpoenaed to testify and/or produce their records. Record keeping and the therapist’s obligation regarding the production of records as well as the therapist’s role as a witness will be examined.
