Clinicians today face interesting choices selecting among available treatments, varying from transdiagnostic approaches, (e.g., the Unified Protocol), to domain approaches, (e.g., Parent Management Training [PMT]), to single disorder approaches, (e.g., Parent-Child Interaction Therapy for Selective Mutism).

Steven Kurtz, PhD, ABPP will present on empirically-supported contemporary approaches to ameliorating childhood internalizing and externalizing disorders. He will compare and contrast several child, parent, and parent-child interactive therapies. Dr. Kurtz will highlight the common elements as well as unique characteristics of some of these therapies, using clinical examples and videos to highlight varying approaches.

Dr. Kurtz brings his 30+ years of experience to us. He has been a Rocklander since 1986, and was in private practice in Nanuet and New City from 1986-1999. He was the inaugural Clinical Director of the Institute for ADHD and Disruptive Behavior Disorders and the co-founder of the Selective Mutism Program at the NYU Child Study Center and was on the faculty of the NYU Langone School of Medicine (1999-2010). In 2010, he became the founding Senior Director of ADHD and Clinical Director of Selective Mutism Programs at the Child Mind Institute, where he remained until 2014. In 2014, he founded Kurtz Psychology Consulting PC, where he provides treatment to families along with his staff, post-doctoral and pre-doctoral trainees. Dr. Kurtz's Selective Mutism programs are replicated worldwide. He is widely published in peer reviewed journals and has appeared on NBC Today Show, ABC Nightline, CBS Early Morning Show, PBS Keeping Kids Healthy, TLC Shalom in the Home, and was featured in PBS ADD & Lovin' It.
